

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF YORK BOARD OF TRUSTEES SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**

**TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 2019**

*Purpose – to hold Public Hearing for questions/comments on proposed budgets for Fiscal Year commencing 4/1/2019 and ending 3/31/2020*

Supervisor Tellas called the Special Board meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. at the York Township Hall, 11560 Stony Creek Road, Milan, MI. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. A Roll Call of Board Members found Chuck Tellas, Sally Louis, Brian Iott, John Hargrove and Helen Neill present. Absent: Derek Stern, Dan Pichla. This special meeting was conducted because there was not a quorum to conduct business at the special meeting called for the Budget Public Hearing held on March 12, 2019.

Short Public Comments: none heard.

MOVED BY TELLAS to approve the York Charter Township Board of Trustees Special 7:30 p.m. meeting agenda for March 26, 2019, as presented. SECONDED BY HARGROVE. Discussion: none. Voice Vote: Aye: 5; Nay: 0; Absent: 2.

MOVED BY LOUIS to close the Regular session and open the York Charter Township Budget Public Hearing for comments and questions regarding the proposed 2019/2020 Fiscal Year Budgets at 7:33 p.m. SECONDED BY IOTT. Discussion: none. VOICE VOTE: AYE: 5; NAY: 0; ABSENT: 2.

**Budget Public Hearing: the property tax millage rate proposed to be levied to support the proposed 2019/2020 FY budget to be a part of this hearing’s discussion.** Supervisor Tellas opened the hearing by requesting comments and questions of the public and advised that the property tax millage rate of one mill for operating and 1-1/2 mills of voter-approved mills for Public Safety will be levied to support the proposed 2019/2020 Fiscal Year budgets. He commented that the Township is in very good financial shape due to the Toyota facility. Board members thanked Supervisor Tellas for all the work he put into preparing and finalizing the budgets. He then requested a second time, comments or questions of the public with none heard. Supervisor Tellas asked a third and final time for comments or questions regarding the proposed 2019/2020 Fiscal Year Budgets with none heard. This year saw the purchase of new office chairs, two new furnaces to replace 18-year-old units on the west side of the Hall, hired goats to clean up brush in the Sandra Richardson Park, etc. This coming year could include updating the meeting hall. Supervisor Tellas then requested a motion to close the Public Hearing.

MOVED BY LOUIS to close the York Township Budget Public Hearing on proposed 2019/2020 FY Budgets at 7:36 p.m. after Supervisor Tellas called for comments and questions three times, as required, and return to the Regular session of the March 26, 2019 Special meeting.  
SECONDED BY HARGROVE. Discussion: Supervisor Tellas advised with this Special meeting having had a quorum present, the Board is in compliance with holding the required Budget Public Hearing for the proposed 2019-2020 Fiscal Year. VOICE VOTE: AYE: 5; NAY: 0; ABSENT: 2.

Adjournment: Moved by Tellas, Seconded by Iott to adjourn the Special Board meeting at 7:38 p.m. Discussion: none. Voice Vote: Aye: 5; Nay: 0; Absent: 2. Carried.
