

Increase in Recycle Rates by Stevens Disposal

In a May 28 letter to York Charter Township, Stevens Disposal requested a substantial increase above the contract for recycling services. The demand for recycled paper, cardboard, plastic and glass have fallen dramatically since China is no longer buying. In a June 7 meeting with their sales representative we asked Stevens to prepare a contract amendment for consideration by our Board and a website address where we can track the market price for recycled products.

On July 2 residents began calling the township about an unannounced increase in billing rates for recycling services.

At the August 13, 2019 Regular Meeting of the York Charter Township Board of Trustees, the price increase request for recycling services from Stevens Disposal was approved effective November 1, 2019 for bills sent in October. Those not wishing to pay the recycling increase may cancel this service by calling Stevens Disposal before the due date.

Residents who paid the higher rate for recycling services for the period beginning August 1, 2019 may request a credit adjustment from Stevens. After November 1, you may pay the higher rate or choose to cancel recycling services.
